# What Is Watch D.O.G.S.?

**WATCH D.O.G.S.** (Dads Of Great Students) is the safe school initiative of the National Center for Fathering *www.fathers.com* which involves fathers and father figures to help create a more safe and secure learning environment in our nation's schools.

Their stated **objective** is to: "Engage men, inspire children, reduce bullying and enhance the educational environment at your school."

### Program Benefits From National Director, Eric Snow.

- Schools gain an extra set of eyes and ears. The presence of a father or father-figure enhances a sense of security at the building for students and staff and helps create an environment conducive to learning.
- Students gain a positive male role model. Many students do not have a father-figure present in their home and benefit when a positive male role model is present.
- Fathers get a glimpse of their student's everyday world and learn about the increasingly complex challenges and decisions today's youth are facing. As a result, they can learn to relate better to their student and hopefully connect with them.
- Fathers gain a greater awareness of the positive impact they can have on their student's life in three critical areas including: academic performance, self esteem and social behavior.

## Requirements/Registration

Any adult male figure in a child's life is welcome to join. In the past, we have had dads, uncles, grandpas, and family friends who are great role models! In order to sign up you will need:

- 1. A completed Snohomish School District Volunteer Packet/Background Check (every 2 years)
- 2. A completed WATCH D.O.G.S Registration Form (every year)

\*Note: Both must be verified EACH school year, no exception.

Completed documentation should be turned in to the Seattle Hill Elementary Office as soon as possible for verification (preferably at least 1 week before your scheduled volunteer date).

## Watch D.O.G.S. Support Education and Safety!

#### These Men Will:

- Wear their Official Uniform T-shirt only at school while performing official WatchDOGS' duties.
- ENCOURAGE STUDENTS! (with lots of smiles and high fives, etc.)
- Help with traffic flow of vehicles and students at arrival and dismissal times
- Monitor hallways and entrances
- Monitor buildings inside/outside. Report any issues to the front office.
- Assist and monitor lunch and recess \*Eat lunch with your own student(s)!
- Read to students or work with small groups of students
- Work with students on flash cards, educational games, or technology support
- Actively and positively engage with students
- Support art and science with your presence, talents and extra hands!
- Deliver items to the classrooms
- Assist with tasks in the front office or around the school
- Assist teachers with putting up or taking down bulletin boards
- Help teachers with a variety of classroom tasks
- · Be chaperone on fieldtrips
- Help students with test review
- Reinforce school policies of good conduct and sense of community
- Report any bullying, discipline issues or concerns to staff to address.
- · Smile and be a hero for a day!

### WATCH D.O.G.S. Should Not:

- Enter any student restroom (Please use the men's restroom in the main office)
- Be alone or unsupervised with students
- Espouse political or religious beliefs to students
- Discipline students
- Sell or give their official WATCH D.O.G.S. T-shirt or hat to someone who isn't an approved WATCH D.O.G.S. volunteer.
- Wear their Official WATCH D.O.G.S. Uniform T-shirt or hat anywhere except at school.
- Engage in any conduct that brings disrespect to himself or his student(s), the school and the WATCH D.O.G.S.® Program and other volunteering fathers.

**Confidentiality** School volunteers are expected to keep confidential any information about the school (pupils, teachers, parents, staff and principals) which might be granted while volunteering. \*Should you have any concerns regarding a student's safety, immediately notify the school principal or staff member.

## WATCH D.O.G.S. GEAR

If you are a WATCH D.O.G., we ask that you wear an identifiable vest on campus. We have one vest that rotates to all WATCH D.O.G.S. If you are a WATCH D.O.G. we encourage you to purchase a hat or shirt (both if possible) to help identify you as a WATCH D.O.G. - 8:30 Classroom: Reading with students
- 9:30 Classroom: Math with students

11:00 Computer Lab

#### Lunch/Recess

1:00 Classroom: Science Lab or Art with students

#### Recess

- 2:30 Gym: PE
- 3:10 Parking Lot ~ Saying good-bye to kids and helping them get in cars/buses
- 3:15 Turn in walkie-talkie radio and name badge
